ODOR RECOGNITION TESTS

Odors: Birch, Anise, Clove

Saturday, June 1, 2018

***Salisbury Presbyterian Church
13621 Salisbury Road, Midlothian, VA 23113***

This test will be inside in a climate-controlled gymnasium with a non-slip vinyl overlay basketball court floor. It is part of the church's multipurpose building. There is no indoor crating space. The parking lot is paved but not shaded. The pathway to and from the parking lot to the test area may require you to navigate uneven terrain, including gravel and asphalt walkways. Due to unforeseen conditions, such as weather or change in availability of areas at the location, the expected test area, parking, and/or pathways may be modified at the last minute.

Entry method – First received By USPS Mail. Overnight deliveries must have the signature waived box checked.

Entries close May 15, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. or when entry limits have been met.

Entries are LIMITED to 100 tests.

Test Site Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Details regarding check in time and briefing will be sent approximately 1 week before the ORT.

Test Site Information

There is no indoor crating space, and also limited shade. Please be prepared and bring shade cloths and water. Please clean up after your dog. Exhibitors caught not cleaning up after their dog will be excused from the test without refund. Dog waste should be deposited in the cans provided throughout the site. Potty areas will be limited to the parking area and adjacent field. The grass immediately surrounding the church sanctuary is off limits.

All dogs must be on a 6' leash at all times when not being tested. No flexi-leashes for walking dogs on test site grounds; flexis may be used in the test itself.

Entry Requirements

The handler of the dog must be a current member of the NACSW™. The Dog must be registered with the NACSW™. For information on how to register or become a member go to www.NACSW.net

Trial Eligibility and ORTs

An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening date to be eligible for the first draw period.

Entry Fee and Second Dog Policy

\$35 per odor per dog. Birch: two-dog entry limit. Anise: two-dog entry limit. Clove: two-dog entry limit. Please fill out a separate entry form for each dog and odor to be tested

Closing Date

May 15, 2019

Overnight mail entries must have the signature request waived.

Refund Policy

Cancellations made on or before May 15, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. will be refunded minus a \$10 administration fee. No refunds after the entry closing date. Cancellations may be made by email (pawsplustrainingva@gmail.com) or telephone: 804-883-0196 during business hours. The secretary is not responsible for lost e-mails or calls that do not reach her. The secretary will send an email back to the participant confirming the cancellation within 36 business hours.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the NACSW™ official or judge.

Video/Photography Policy

ORT participants are allowed to have a friend or family member video/photograph their test. ORT participants are not allowed to video/photograph one another. ORT hosts are not obligated to provide someone to video/photograph.

Results

During the odor re-sets, the official results sheet will be brought out to the parking area for testers to photo or review. We recommend you verify your results on the official results sheet and let your host or judge know if you have any questions regarding your results.

Directions to Test Site

From the NORTH – Follow I-95 to I-295 North. Continue on I-295 North until you reach I-64W toward Charlottesville. Merge onto I-64 West via Exit 53A for 2.5 miles. Merge onto VA-288 South via Exit 175 toward Chesterfield. Follow VA-288 S for 8.4 miles to the Huguenot Trail exit. Turn Left onto Huguenot Trail and follow for 1.5 miles. Huguenot Trail becomes Robious Road. Follow for 2.1 miles. Turn Right on Salisbury Road and follow for 1.1 miles to site on the right. Turn onto Starcross Road to get into the church parking lots and look for people to assist you with parking.

From NC and points SOUTH of Richmond – Follow I-95 North. Merge onto VA-288 North via Exit 62 toward Chesterfield/Powhite Parkway. Follow 20 miles. Merge onto Midlothian Turnpike/US-60 E toward Midlothian. Follow 1.8 miles. Turn left onto Winterfield Road for 1.4 miles. Pass through one roundabout. Turn right onto W. Salisbury Road. Follow 1.1 miles to site. Turn onto Starcross Road to get into the church parking lots and look for people to assist you with parking.

From Charlottesville and points West of Richmond – Follow I-64 East to VA-288 South via Exit 175 toward Chesterfield. Follow VA-288 S for 8.4 miles to the Huguenot Trail exit. Turn Left onto Huguenot Trail and follow for 1.5 miles. Huguenot Trail becomes Robious Road. Follow for 2.1 miles. Turn Right on Salisbury Road and follow for 1.1 miles to site on the right. Turn onto Starcross Road to get into the church parking lots and look for people to assist you with parking.

From Williamsburg and points East of Richmond – Follow I-64 West to I-295 South via exit 200 toward Rocky Mount, NC. Merge onto I-295 South and follow for 3 miles. Merge onto VA-895 West/Pocahontas Parkway via Exit 25 toward Richmond (Portions toll.) for 1.4 miles. Merge onto VA-150 North/Chippenham Parkway via exit on the left. Continue for 7.9 miles (portions toll). Merge onto 60 West/Midlothian Turnpike toward Midlothian. Turn right on Robious Road and follow for 3.8 miles. Turn left on Salisbury Road and follow 1.1 miles to site. Turn onto Starcross Road to get into the church parking lots and look for people to assist you with parking.

TEST Information - Notice to Exhibitors

THE TEST SITE will be open from **8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.**

CHECK-IN/HANDLER BRIEFING 8:15 a.m. – NOTE EXACT TIME WILL BE NOTED IN THE CONFIRMATION EMAIL. Details regarding check in time and briefing will be sent approximately 1 week before the ORT.

An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening date to be eligible for the first draw period.

NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE SEARCH AREA during the ORT except NACSW™ officials, adults accompanying a minor, CNWI-in-training, or immediate family members/friends of the dog/handler team currently being tested.

ENTRIES:

- TELEPHONE, FAX, UNSIGNED ENTRIES, AND ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES cannot be accepted.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. <host policy for returned checks>.
- ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON THE ATTACHED ENTRY FORM.
- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- OWNERS are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.
- EXPRESS MAIL entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged. Be prepared to keep your dog in your car when not being tested or on leash at all times.

There is no inside crating at this test.

FEMALES IN SEASON – Contact your test host at least 1 day before the ORT if this becomes a possibility

DOGS PARTICIPATING in ORT must be at least six months of age and must appear to be healthy on trial day and should be current on all vaccinations required by law.

Acknowledgement of entry acceptance/CONFIRMATION will be made when entries are processed for those handlers that provide an email address. If you require a confirmation via USPS, you must provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry.

BASIC DESCRIPTION OF TEST – to successfully pass an ORT a dog must identify the location of the target odor and the handler must correctly call an “alert” within a three-minute time period. The Odor Recognition Test consists of a drill type exercise which requires 12 closed boxes set up in a pattern of *one or two* rows, spaced a minimum of 48” apart. The ORT is conducted on leash. Complete information can be obtained on the NACSW™ website.
